

Make A Cat-sicle!

Sure to give you one cool cat this summer...

Time Required

- 5 minutes to prep
- 2 - 4 hours to freeze

Supplies Needed

- Spatula or spoon
- Cat wet food
- Ice-cube tray OR small freezer-safe pet food container
- Optional: Cat treats and added water



Instructions

1. Put a small amount of wet food inside each ice cube tray.
 - a. For added hydration, mix 1/2 teaspoon of water in each cube
2. Pack food into the bottom of each cube and push 1-2 cat treats into the middle for an extra surprise.
3. Put in freezer for at least 2 hours or overnight.
4. Share with your cat for a cool and refreshing snack!



Feline Friend Facts

5 Signs of Dehydration in Cats

- Sunken, dull eyes
- Reduced or loss of appetite
- Elevated breathing and heart rate
- Saliva thick and ropey, gums dry and tacky
- Decreased skin elasticity
