

# DIY Snuffle Mat

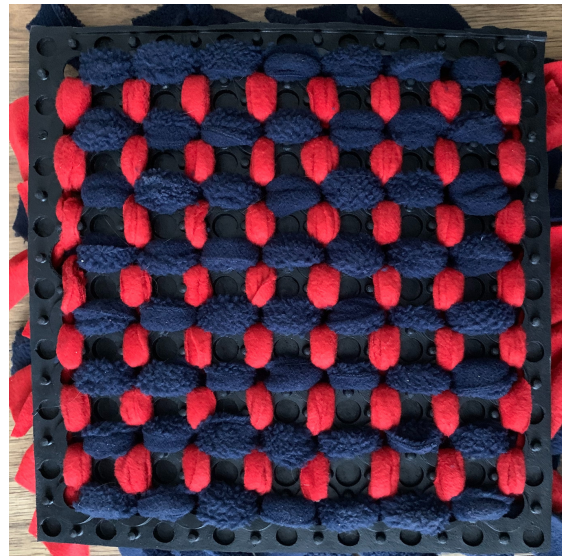
## Supplies

- Old Fleece Blanket
- Scissors
- Solid Base with holes about 12in (30.5cm) by 15in (38cm)
  - Cardboard box
  - Rubber Dish mat
  - Rubber floor mat

## Time Required



- Approximately 60-90 minutes to make.

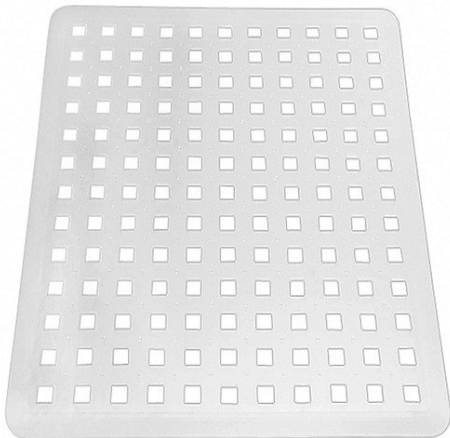


## Steps

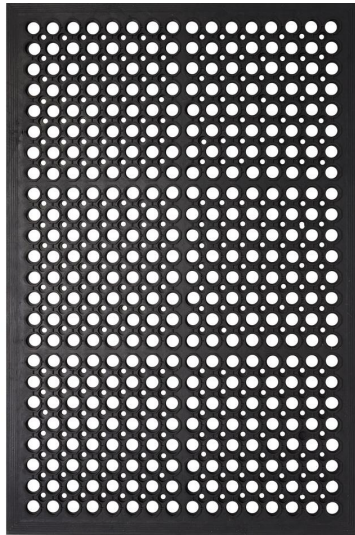
1. Cut fleece blanket into strip about 1 in by 6in (2.5cm by 15cm)
2. Take the base and poke the strip through the first hole in the top corner and then feed it back through the hole directly beside. Tie a knot. Repeat this for the entire first row.
3. Continue each row until the mat is covered.
4. You will then need to repeat these steps but instead of horizontally tying the knots you will vertically tie. (See photo for more detail)
5. Once all knots are tied, place the item on the floor then add and burry treats in the folds for your pet to find!

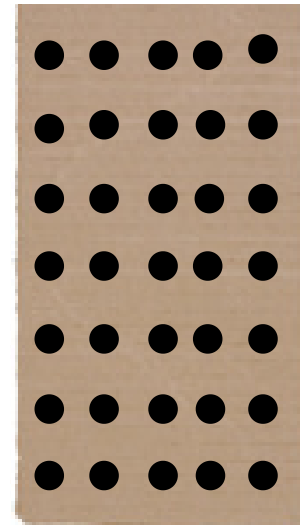
## Base Options



Rubber Dish Mat

Cardboard with Holes



For the best results, use mats that are around 12 inches (30.5 cm) by 15 inches (38cm) and the holes are about 1 inch (2.5 cm) apart.



**NOTE:** Always supervise your pet while playing with the snuffle mat so they do not start chewing or eating the actual mat.
