# Key Features to Look For

- Easy to Clean: Choose a carrier with materials that are easy to wipe down and sanitize.
- **Secure Closures:** Be cautious with soft carriers, as their zippers can sometimes be opened by a determined cat, posing a risk during travel.
- **Non-Slip Flooring:** Ensure the carrier's floor isn't slippery. Adding a blanket or a non-slip pad, like a cut yoga mat, can help your cat feel more secure.
- Fresh Start: If your cat has had negative experiences with a particular carrier, consider switching to a new style. If that's not an option, thoroughly clean the existing carrier with unscented soap and add your cat's bedding to make it more inviting.

## A Note on Backpack Carriers

Backpack carriers can seem like a fun and convenient option, but they come with some cautions:

- **Size and Comfort**: Many backpacks are too small for an average cat and lack sufficient space for them to lie down comfortably. Always check the dimensions before purchasing.
- **Stability:** Backpacks can bounce around during walks, making the ride uncomfortable. Wear the backpack on your front so you can stabilize it with your arms, monitor your cat's reactions and offer treats to create positive associations.
- **Ventilation:** Poor airflow in some backpacks can lead to overheating. Choose one with adequate ventilation and monitor your cat's breathing.
- **Structure:** Soft-shelled carriers and backpacks may collapse under the weight of a cat. Select a backpack with a rigid frame that maintains its shape.
